

Richter divests its wholesale and retail operation in the Republic of Moldova

Budapest, Hungary – 21 June 2021 – Gedeon Richter Plc. ("Richter") today announces that it has signed a multi-party agreement to divest its wholesale operation to Grin-Farm S.R.L. ("Grin-Farm") and its retail operations to BIRIVOFARM S.R.L. ("BIRIVOFARM"), both in the Republic of Moldova. Richter as a majority owner of both the wholesale and the retail operations is entitled to approximately 62% of the purchase price, which is receivable upon the closure of the deal.

"This agreement complements the strategic shift Richter has been executing over the past decade and it protects high margins achieved by its core, highly specialised pharmaceutical business segment," – said Mr Gábor Orbán, CEO of Richter.

(www.richter.hu), headquartered in Budapest/Hungary, is a major pharmaceutical company in Central Eastern Europe, with an expanding direct presence in Western Europe, in China and in Latin America. Having reached a market capitalization of EUR 3.8 billion (USD 4.7 billion) by the end of 2020, Richter's consolidated sales were approximately EUR 1.6 billion (USD 1.8 billion) during the same year.
